Those who should attend include Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, Coaches, Committee Members, Organizational Representatives, or anyone interested in learning basic outdoor camping skills. Emphasis will be placed upon learning the following skills:

Campsite Selection; Leave No Trace Camping; Tents; Ropes: Whipping, Tying & Lashing; Woods Tools: Knife, Camp Saw, and Axe; Finding Your Way: Map & Compass Reading; Plant Identification; Animal Identification; Fires: Site Selection & Building; Cooking; Backpacking & Hiking Techniques: Packs & Footwear.
