Summer Camp Program: Camp Lowden offers a great summer camp program. The summer camp staff is outstanding and helps scouts earn many different merit badges. While this is a fantastic camp for first and second year scouts, there is something here for everyone! Camp Lowden offers a high adventure program that includes hiking, sail boarding, river rafting, climbing and zip lining. The Nature Area at camp is run extremely well. Camp Lowden also offers a Cub Scout Family Camp during the summer months. The weekends are fast paced with games, crafts, nature, archery, BB gun, campfires, advancement work and more.

Facilities Description: Camp Lowden is a very compact camp with everything easy to get to. There is a nice sized swimming pool, but because of weather and environmental conditions, there is no lake to swim in. There is a fully enclosed dining hall and also a newly renovated fire bowl. The camp also has a training facility called the Boeger Leadership Lodge that can be used for trainings. There is also an archery and rifle range.

Out of Season Camping: Camp Lowden offers year round camping! The camp holds training courses, camporees, Klondike derbies and other Cub Scout Day Camps throughout the year. There are eight campsites and also six cabins that can be rented for units.
