**Description:** Canyon Camp is a Boy Scout camp located near Stockton, IL. Founded in 1932, the camp officially became a Boy Scout Camp on July 12, 1936. Today, the camp is 283 acres of wilderness and great scouting! It currently offers 6 weeks of Boy Scout Camp and a week of Venture Camp each summer. The camp is available to be rented in the off-season by scouts, schools, and youth groups.

**Summer Camp Program:** There are six weeks of summer camp and one week of Venture camp.

**Facilities Description:** All summer campsites are equipped with two-man wall tents on platforms with two beds. All meals are served in the dining hall and there is a full advancement program including opportunities to earn over 40 merit badges. Other facilities include: handicraft lodge, medical lodge, fully-equipped pool/shower house, nature lodge, activities pavilion, and a Jamboree cabin which houses Eagle-required merit badges.

**Out of Season Camping:** Canyon Camp offers two cabins for rent in the off-season. The Founders' Lodge is located above the camp pool and sleeps 30. The Jamboree Cabin is located by Tall Timber campsite and sleeps 20.

**Unique Features:** Canyon Camp is nestled in a scenic canyon on the banks of Coon Creek. Its unique program features a popular, long-standing, Wednesday night visitors' program which includes Native American dancing and an impressive Order of the Arrow call out ceremony.
