Description: Nestled on two lakes in the pine woods just seven miles from Wild Rose, WI lies one of Wisconsin's best keep camping secrets; Napowan Adventure Base. For over 60 years, Napowan has provided real life learning and fun for scouts from all across the country. In 2011 the camp served more than 3,000 scouts and leaders from all over the Midwest. Opportunity is abounding at Napowan; whether you're a first-year Tenderfoot or a seasoned Eagle Scout. There is something for everyone at Napowan Adventure Base!

Summer Camp Program: Napowan offers seven weeks of summer camp. During these weeks they offer merit badges and other programs. Napowan Adventure Base not only has 50+ merit badges offered for campers, but has such a vast spectrum of non-merit badge opportunities. These opportunities include open swimming and boating in afternoons, high adventure climbing, tomahawk throwing, rocket launching, hiking, and much more.

Facilities Description: Napowan Adventure Base's unique experience is enhanced by the numerous facilities that are used for seasonal or year round purposes. The Northwest Suburban Council Capital Campaign has helped improve the facilities to offer the best experience possible at Napowan Adventure Base. At Napowan there

are indoor and outdoor facilities for training and activities. There are three main indoor areas for sleeping. The OA Cabin has a capacity of 22 people, the Terra Building with a capacity of 30, and the Staff Huts has a total capacity of 60 people. At Napowan there is a new dining facility and also new showers and restroom facilities. There are over 30 campsites, a high ropes course, and there are two lakes on the property.

Out of Season Camping:

Although Napowan is primarily used as a summer scout reservation, this camp is available to all organizations in the off-season. Starting in mid-August, going until early June, organizations can come and have an adventurous retreat, designed to meet your needs. Waushara County has some great neighbors of the camp and opportunity is abounding with off-season activities. Whether you are looking for a Lock-In Retreat or a Vertical Limit extreme experience all is located within 3 miles of the camp.

Unique Features:

Napowan offers special program areas during the summer. One of these is called Flintlock which includes a fully functional blacksmithing forge, a print shop, as well as leatherwork and woodcarving areas. Napowan contains a fully enclosed rifle range as well as archery and shotgun ranges. Napowan also provides motorboats and the motorboat merit badge. The motorboat merit badge is done in one of the two lakes that Napowan has access to which is also the lake used for swimming. The second lake accessible from Napowan provides canoeing, rowing, kayaking, and small boat sailing.
